City of Freeport, Illinois Proposed adoption of Redevelopment Plan and Project and Designation of a Redevelopment Project Area - Notice is hereby given that, on July 7, 2014, at 6 pm, the City of Freeport will hold a public hearing at the City Hall, 3rd Floor in Council Chambers, 524 W. Stephenson Street, Freeport, Illinois, to consider the approval of a proposed redevelopment plan (the "Redevelopment Plan") and the designation of a proposed redevelopment project area to be known as the Meadows Redevelopment Project Area (the "Redevelopment Project Area"). At the hearing, comments will be heard on the Draft Redevelopment Plan and Project and the designation of the Redevelopment Project Area and adoption of tax increment allocation financing therefore. The proposed Redevelopment Plan and Project is on file and available for public inspection at the Office of the City Clerk at 524 W. Stephenson Street, Freeport, Illinois. It is also available for viewing on the City of Freeport website (www.cityoffreeport.org) under Community Development Department. As set forth in the Redevelopment Plan and Project, the City proposes to alleviate certain conditions that without intervention will result in the Redevelopment Project Area becoming a blighted area; and to enhance the tax base of the City and the taxing districts having taxable property within the Redevelopment Project Area. The Plan shall expire by a date not later than 23 years from the adoption of the Ordinance approving the Redevelopment Project Area, which shall occur no later than December 31, 2037. At the hearing, all interested persons or affected taxing districts may file written objections with the City Clerk and may be heard orally with respect to any issues regarding the approval of the Redevelopment Plan and Project, the designation of the Redevelopment Project Area and the adoption of tax increment allocation financing. The hearing may be adjourned by the Mayor and City Council of the City without further notice other than a motion to be entered upon the minutes of the hearing fixing the time and place of the subsequent hearing.
